

CRUISING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

RISK STATEMENT

It must be recognised that sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, you agree and acknowledge that:

1. You are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and you accept responsibility exposing yourself to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the Rally.
2. You agree to comply at all times with the requests of the Rally Coordinator.
3. You accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by your own negligence.
4. You will not participate in the Rally whilst your ability to skipper or crew the vessel is impaired by alcohol, drugs or whilst otherwise unfit.
5. You are aware of any specific risks drawn to your attention by the Rally Coordinator.
6. The safety of your vessel & her crew is solely your responsibility.
7. The vessel is insured for the type of event being participated in.
8. You have read the MYC Ltd Cruising Policy Document and agree to abide by its contents.

CANCELLATION

You understand that the Rally Coordinator may cancel or postpone the Rally at any stage in the event of bad weather or otherwise.

MISCONDUCT

You understand that the Rally Coordinator may exclude anyone from a particular Rally or part thereof and report anyone to the House Committee who refuses to comply with these Registration Terms or who misconducts themselves in any way or who causes damage or annoyance to other persons.

DATA PROTECTION

The information given by you on your Registration Form will be used by us to process your registration in accordance with the Club's Data Protection Policy, and for attending to you whilst in the Rally.
