SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AMENDMENT 1

5 <u>SCHEDULE OF RACES</u> is replaced by:

- 5.1 Time permitting, the Regatta will comprise a series of 3 races for each class,
- 5.2 The 2nd and 3rd Race will follow as soon as possible after the completion of the earlier race.
- 5.3 2nd race will include an optional 'Ladies Helm' Race
- 5.4 The first Warning Signal will be at 11.55am

- 6 ENTRY AND IDENTIFICATION is replaced by:
 - 6.1 Entry is free and all boats entering the Starting Area will be treated as entered.
 - 6.2 As boats enter the starting area they should contact the Race Officer on Channel 6 to provide:
 - 6.2.1 their boat name, sail number and YTC number and confirm both their intention to race;
 - 6.2.2 indicate whether they intend whether or not to use downwind sails;
 - 6.2.3 Notify the Race Officer if they wish to enter the optional Ladies Helm Race.
 - 21 PRIZE GIVING AND PRIZES is replaced by:
 - 21.1 The Prizegiving will be held in the Club as soon as possible after racing has finished.
 - 21.2 All competitors are invited back to the Club and Mylor Yacht Harbour has kindly offered to allow visiting boats to tie up on their outer pontoon.
 - 21.3 There will be overall series prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each Class.
 - 21.4 Separate prizes will also be awarded for the Ladies Helm Race
