

MYLOR YACHT CLUB HANDICAPPING POLICY

Reviewed & Revised January 2024

- 1. The aim of this policy is to assist the achievement of fair racing at Mylor Yacht Club (MYC), as required by the Racing Rules of Sailing Rule 2, by setting a boat's handicap in a fair, open and transparent manner.
- 2. Boats compete at MYC race using the RYA Yacht Time Correction System (YTC).
- 3. Receipt of the online MYC Race Entry Form (and fee if applicable: see the Notice of Race) means that a boat is entered for all MYC races during the calendar year that the entry is received. However, a result will not be given unless the boat has been issued a handicap.
- 4. All entrants must complete all the information required on the MYC Race Entry Form and the RYA YTC Application Form. Both forms must be submitted each year.
- 5. A boat's YTC number will be generated using the formulae as defined in the YTC Policy & Procedures at https://www.swytc.org.uk/index.asp
- 6. Failure to complete the Handicap Form may result in a temporary handicap number being issued until the necessary boat data has been obtained and checked, and the necessary calculations have been completed. Late entries may also be allocated a temporary handicap number, until the appropriate calculations can be completed.
- 7. A temporary handicap number shall not be altered; any results using this number will stand and will not be altered retrospectively.
- 8. Queries concerning individual handicaps shall be made by email to admin@swytc.org.uk Note. The boat's YTC number may be used at other events in the PoFSA area & other clubs in the South West.
